Strategies - IQAC shall evolve mechanisms and procedures for:

1. Timely, efficient and progressive performance of academic, administrative and financial tasks.
2. The relevant and quality of academic and research programmes.
3. Equitable access to and affordability of academic programmes for various section of society.
4. Optimization and integration of modern methods of teaching and learning.
5. The creditability of evaluation procedures.
6. The adequacy, maintenance and proper allocation of support structure and services.
7. Research sharing and networking with other institution in India and abroad.

Functions

Some of the functions excepted of the IQAC are:

1. Development and application of quality benchmarks/parameters for the various academic and administrative activities of the institutions.
2. Dissemination of information on the various quality parameters of higher education.
3. Organization of workshops, seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles.



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4. Documentation of the various programmes/activities leading to quality improvement.
5. Acting as a nodal agency of the institution for quality-related activities

Benefits - IQAC will facilitates/contribute:

1. To a heightened level of clarity and focus in institutional functioning towards quality enhancement and facilitate internalization of the quality culture.
2. To enhancement and integration among the various activities of the institution and institutionalize many good practices.
3. To provide a sound basis for decision-making to improve institutional functioning.
4. To act as a change agent in the institution.
5. To better internal communication
