**Sub: Provisional affiliation for establishment of Law College i.e. Puran Murti College of Law, Kami Road, Sonapat, Haryana for running LL.B. (Hons)- 3 Year and B.A.LL.B. (Hons)- 5 year Program with an intake of 120 seats in each for/from the session 2023-24.**

Sir,

Kindly refer to your proposal regarding establishment of new Law College i.e. **Puran Murti College of Law, Kami Road, Sonapat, Haryana** on the above noted subject.

On the basis of report of the Inspection Committee which visited your proposed college on 10.06.2023 to verify the infrastructural facilities required for running LL.B. (Hons)- 3 year and B.A.LL.B. (Hons)- 5 year Program with an intake of 120 seats in each for/from the session 2023-24, the Vice-Chancellor, in anticipation approval of the Academic Council/Executive Council, has been pleased to grant provisional affiliation for establishment of Law College i.e. **Puran Murti College of Law, Kami Road, Sonapat, Haryana for running LL.B. (Hons)- 3 Year and B.A.LL.B. (Hons)- 5 year Program with an intake of 120 seats in each for/from the session 2023-24**, subject to the approval of the Academic Council/Executive Council of the University, which will be binding on your college.


The above provisional affiliation is granted subject to approval of the Central Body i.e. BCI, New Delhi and fulfillment of all the observations/ shortcomings pointed out by the Inspection Committee in its report dated 12.06.2023 (copy enclosed). The admissions to the said courses shall be made through the competent authority of the College/Institute by following the schedule of admission prescribed by the Academic Branch of this University after the receipt of approval of Bar Council of India, New Delhi. The above provisional affiliation is further subject to the following mandatory conditions:

1. The Institute shall constitute Governing Body as per Central Body/University norms.
2. The admissions will not exceed beyond the sanctioned intake.
3. The teaching and all other staff shall be appointed through properly constituted Selection Committee and with prior approval of the University as per University Norms. CPF scheme must be introduced. Service rules for teaching/non-teaching staff should be framed and a copy be sent to the University
4. The faculty shall be appointed as per Central Body/BCI/University norms in the pay scales prescribed by it from time to time.
5. The fee structure prescribed by the State Govt./ University shall be strictly followed.
6. All academic, physical and other infrastructural facilities shall be continued to be provided/upgraded by the institute as prescribed by the Central Body/University from time to time.
7. The institute shall furnish requisite documents and reports as called for by the University from time to time in order to ensure proper maintenance of the infrastructural facilities and academic standards.
8. The information furnished in respect of above courses shall be factual and correct. In the event of any information found to be false, misleading or suppressed, the provisional affiliation shall be withdrawn by the University without any notice.
9. In the event of non compliance of the University Act/Statutes/Ordinance/Rules and Regulations and any other instructions/guidelines issued from time to time, the University shall be free to withdraw the provisional affiliation and all liabilities arising out of such a withdrawal would solely lie on the concerned society/institute.
10. The institute shall follow the mode of selection of candidates for admissions as approved by the Central Body/State Govt./University.
11. The institute shall provide all Academic and Infrastructural facilities including classrooms, hostels, library, laboratories, workshops, play grounds and other amenities required for the smooth conduct of its affairs as per Central Body/BCI/University Norms.
12. The Trust/ Society shall not change the location of the institute without prior approval of the Central Body.

13. **Building:** The entire building of the College will be at the disposal of the Controller of Examinations for the purpose of Conduct of examinations as and when, the 'Centre of Examination (for theory and practical both) is created, it will be obligatory for the Principal to provide necessary infrastructure for smooth conduct of examination.
  14. **Examination Centre:** Creation of an Examination Centre in the College will be at the discretion of the Controller of Examinations. The Centre of examinations for the students studying in the College can be shifted to any other College. In such a situation, it will be the responsibility of the institution to make arrangements for transporting the students to the Centre of Examinations without any extra charges from the students. Similarly, the University can also shift the students of other Colleges/Institutes to the College/Institution under reference for which necessary infrastructure will have to be provided by the Principal concerned.
  15. **Staff:** For the purpose of conduct of examinations, the services of entire teaching and non-teaching staff will be at the disposal of the Controller of Examinations. The examination duties can be assigned to any member of teaching and non-teaching staff which will have to be complied with, in the interest of smooth conduct of examinations.
  16. **Strong Room:** There will be a strong Room in the College at the prime location adjacent to the office of the Principal to keep the confidential material of the University as and when required. The Strong Room will essentially have double lock system.
- You are, therefore, requested to complete the above requirements/conditions and send compliance report of the same to the University at the earliest so that further action may be taken accordingly. In case of non compliance of above conditions/ requirements, the University shall have the right to refuse the extension of provisional affiliation to the institute for the academic session 2024-25.

**Report of the Inspection Committee that visited Puran Murti College of Law, Kami Road, Sonapat on 10.06.2023 with regard to grant of provisional affiliation for establishment of new Law college namely "Puran Murti College of Law, Kami Road, Sonapat" to run LLB(Hons.) and B.A.LLB(Hons.) program with an intake of 120 each for/from the session 2023-24**

The inspection committee comprising of Prof. Nasib Singh Gill, Dr. Jitender Dhull, Dr. Jaswant Saini and Dr. Surender Dahiya visited Puran Murti College of Law, Kami Road, Sonapat on 10.06.2023 with regard to grant of provisional affiliation for establishment of new Law college namely "Puran Murti College of Law, Kami Road, Sonapat" to run the following programs subject to the approval of Bar Council of India (BCI):

- **LLB(Hons.) program at 1<sup>st</sup> year level with an intake of 120**
- **B.A.LLB(Hons.) program at 1<sup>st</sup> year level with an intake of 120**



**Observations of the Committee**


The committee physically verified the necessary infrastructure facilities, teaching faculty and other support system required for the abovementioned program and makes the following observations:

1. Puran Murti Educational Society, Kami, Distt. Sonapat has proposed the above mentioned College. (Copy of Trust Deed enclosed)
2. The proposed College has 5.0 acres of land and an existing 3-storey building that has been exclusively proposed to be used for the proposed programmes. The site of the College is located on Kami-Sonapat Road, which has good connectivity. (Land records enclosed)
3. **Building Map:** The College has adequate space for the aforesaid programmes. (Copy of Building Plan enclosed)
4. **'NOC' from State Govt.:** The said College has already obtained 'No Objection Certificate' issued from the State Govt. on 11.05.2023 for running the above programmes. (Copy enclosed)
5. **Building:** The 3-storey building houses Principal office, Admin Office, 22 classrooms, 06 tutorial rooms, Moot Court Room, 2 computer laboratories, faculty rooms, faculty cabins, library, Medical Room, Conference/Committee Hall, common rooms for boys and girls, etc. The College has sufficient space and all the classrooms are furnished. (Copy enclosed).
6. **Staff:** The College has already identified Principal and 6 faculty members (all Asstt. Professors of Law) for LLB(Hons.) program and 6 faculty members (all Asstt. Professors) for B.A. LLB(Hons.) program and all the identified are eligible (NET/Ph.D) and are sufficient as per MDU norms. The college has given an Advt. on 7.6.2023 in 2 newspapers for Principal, 12 teaching and non-teaching staff for 12 faculty members and 24 non-teaching staff following MDU norms (copy enclosed). However, the College is required to follow MDU laid procedure for appointment of faculty latest by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023 and thereafter their approval from the University.

The College has already appointed/identified 11 non-teaching staff including Librarian, 2 Lab Attendant, 3 Clerk, 2 Peon, 3 Security men, 3 Safai karmchari, and all were present at the time of visit (Copy enclosed).

7. **Library:** The College has a Library having a stock of in all 3140 books (1050 titles) out of which only 394 books (102 titles) so far have been received against an order of 2378 books (168 titles) against an overall requirement of 2000 books (200 titles) for the both the courses. The college is required to immediately procure the pending books for which the Chairman has also given an undertaking to procure latest by 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023. The Library has subscription of 4 Magazines and 4 Newspapers. However, the college is required to ensure availability of few popular journals, E-journals and database related to Law. (Details and copy of bills enclosed)
8. **Computing Facilities:** The College has two Computer Labs having in all 60 Computers, 6 Printers and adequate UPS backup. The College has an Internet connection of 64 MBPS leased line from BSNL and Wi-Fi access has also been provided. (Details enclosed)
9. The College has adequate furnished classrooms and Tutorial Rooms, which are well furnished and are sufficient for all the above proposed Law programmes.
10. The College has Boys and Girls Hostels on the premises.
11. The College has provision of separate Toilets for Boys and Girls on each floor.
12. The College has spacious common rooms for Boys and Girls.
13. The College has two Gensets, one of 63 KVA and another of 42 KVA.
14. The college has all other general amenities on the campus required for the above programme.
15. **Proformas:** The proformas for both the programs have been filled-up and are available as part of the Inspection File alongwith Inspection Report.

### Recommendations


In view of the above observations, the committee recommends that the proposal of Puran Murti Education Society for establishment of new Law College namely "Puran Murti College of Law, Kami Road, Sonapat" with provisional affiliation may be granted to run the following programs subject to the approval of Bar Council of India (BCI):

- o LLB(Hons.) program at 1<sup>st</sup> year level with an intake of 120
- o B.A.LLB(Hons.) program at 1<sup>st</sup> year level with an intake of 120

for/from the session 2023-24 and the compliance of the deficiencies pointed out by the committee may be verified any day after 30<sup>th</sup> September 2023.
